
SANCTUARY CANDLE

CHURCH HISTORY



The center Grand Altar Window features the Sacred Heart of Christ. At the bottom of the window is the inscription, IHS, which stands for "Iesus Hominum Salvator" or "Jesus Savior of Man." The window was donated by George Mattingly, a resident of Southwest Washington in the 1850s. Before St. Dominic Church was built, Mass was celebrated in the Mattingly's Southwest D.C. home.



CAPITOL HILL PREGNANCY CENTER




