

  - The label "**SM**" means the music is in the blue St Michael's Hymnal
  - The Gloria for all Masses is #164 in the St. Michael's Hymnal.
- Some of our community music is based on easy to remember responses and will not be listed on the hymn board. PLEASE SING!
- Out of solemn respect for the Mass, we follow the custom of remaining at our places within the church until the conclusion of the recessional hymn.
